Defendant

1. I trade as John's Shoes.
2. The Defendant is a company trading as Small Work Wear.
3. On 1 January 2019 in a telephone conversation with the Defendant it was agreed that I would sell him 100 pairs of steel capped boots for \$2,000.00 which was to be paid within 30 days of my invoice.
4. On 2 January 2019 I sold and delivered the 100 pairs of boots to the Defendant.
5. On or about 2 January 2019 I sent the Defendant my invoice for \$2,000.00.
6. Despite demand, the Defendant has failed to pay my invoice within 30 days or at all.

The Claimant claims the following:

- A. the sum of \$2,000.00;
- B. interest on the sum of \$2,000 at 6% per annum pursuant to section 12 of the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* from 1 February 2019 to the date of payment;
- C. allowable costs.
