Information on making and responding to an application

- A supporting affidavit must be lodged with an application.
- A party which has been served with an application must, no later than 14 days from when the party was served with the application, lodge and serve -
 - a) a response to the application stating whether the party consents or objects in relation to each order sought in the application; and
 - b) unless the party consents to every order sought in the application, an affidavit supporting the response; and
 - c) any related application by the party.

The response must be in the approved form.

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
